

PULSE Music Camp 2019 (Student Application)

Tuesday 11 June – Friday 14 June 2019 YMCA Camp Yarramundi

The PULSE Music Camp offers an opportunity for students in Years 5-12 to join together for four days to receive expert training from NSW Department of Education staff and professional musicians in order to develop their performance skills in a range of ensembles. The camp is a NSW Department of Education initiative for talented vocalists and instrumentalists.

In an environment with a strong emphasis on music education, participants rehearse and perform high quality repertoire culminating in a concert for families and friends on the final afternoon of the camp.

Major activities at the four-day residential camp include concert band, vocal ensemble, jazz ensemble, string ensemble and recreational activities.

Student vocalists and students who play orchestral string instruments and concert band instruments are invited to apply. Guitarists and bass guitarists are to be made aware that limited opportunities are available. However, if enough interest in shown, a guitar ensemble will be formed as an additional ensemble.

Students will need to be confident about staying overnight. Any primary student who might be anxious about being away from home for three nights would be best advised to wait until next year to apply for camp.

The cost of the camp is \$350.00. This includes all meals, accommodation, recreational activities and tuition.

Additional Information

- This is a four-day residential camp. **Students are not able to leave the site** during the camp.
- The camp begins at 8:30am on Tuesday 11 June and concludes at 3:00pm on Friday 14 June at the completion of the final concert.
- On Friday 14 June at 1:30pm students will perform as a group in a short concert for parents, principals and teachers. This concert will be in the main hall at the camp.
- Students will need black performance clothes for the concert on Friday. This includes black shirt, black pants or skirt, black shoes and black socks or tights.
- During the camp, students are to wear a dress code of t-shirts and appropriate trousers/jeans, as well as suitable closed in shoes.
- All meals, accommodation and activities are included in the cost of the camp.
- Full payment must accompany all applications. Payment will be returned if the application is not successful.

What to Bring

- Your instrument, including drum sticks/mallets for percussionists
- A Music Stand labelled with your name and school
- At least 3 Lead Pencils preferably 2B
- A pre-prepared 'own choice' piece no longer than 1 minute to play for an informal audition at the start of the camp.
- Spare reeds, strings, etc. as required for your instrument
- Sheet music of own choice and/or backing tracks (for evening performances)
- T-shirts and two pairs of comfortable long pants/jeans
- A warm jumper, jacket or cardigan
- Sleeping bag and pillow case / or sheets, doona and pillow case
- Comfortable closed-in shoes
- Pyjamas, slippers, underwear and socks
- Towel and toiletries
- Black performance clothes (black shirt, black skirt/pants, black shoes, black socks/tights) for the final concert.
- An umbrella or waterproof jacket for wet weather
- A familiar toy, book or game for bedtime
- Hat or cap and sunscreen
- Water Bottle clearly marked with your name
- Any medication cleared labelled in a plastic snap-lock bag
